In this session we will explore typically speech sound development and the patterns we usually see in children when they are first learning to talk. We will demonstrate common errors and processes that you may hear children in your setting use and the ages when we would expect these to resolve.

We will discuss when children require further support to support their speech sound development, what this may look like and what setting staff can do to support this. We will talk about when a referral would be advised for next steps.
